The National drink of Bermuda is said to have been invented by weary Bermudan sailors who added a splash of Dark Rum to their homemade ginger beer. The name comes from the unmistakable murky hue which they likened to the colour of storm clouds.

CLOVER CLUB

This drink pre-dates prohibition in the U.S. and is named after the Gentleman's Club of the same name, which met in Philadelphia's Bellevue-Stratford Hotel. It ticks all the boxes of a classic cocktail; simplicity, pleasant on the palette & an inviting history.

It was loved so much that a certain Brooklyn bar was named in its honour.

FRENCH MARTINI
